Kiddie Korner Daycare

We would like to start off by requesting a prayer for the Angus family. One of our very own dads (Daniel Angus) in the USMC was killed in action Saturday, January 23rd. He was 23 years old.

On a more positive note, we are happy to inform you that Ms. Connie who was with us for 8 years is coming back! She left for a management opportunity at Camelot. After 6 months of missing the children and her KKDC family, she is returning.

We are doing extended care on Monday and Wednesday nights until 8pm, as well as Saturday care. We can do more extended days as needed by parents. We have decided that unless asked, we will open at 4:30 on Saturdays. The dates we have planned for Saturday care in February 13th and 27th. The dates for March will be the 13th and 27th as well. Parents should take advantage of this. Plan a monthly date night or a time to clean your house without interruption. The cost is just \$25 per child or \$35 per family. We provide dinner and activities.

I would like to remind you that your in-service day in April was changed from the 16th to the 12th. You do not pay for that day. Nine staff will be attending the CAEYC conference in Long Beach, CA. Others chose to remain here and do their in-service. We receive intense training getting 6-9 hours in-service hours for attending. To be a childcare teacher you must maintain 18 yearly hours and management must maintain 22 hours.

Kindermusik has started for children ages 2-5 years on Tuesday afternoons. Please let us know if you're interested. We will be doing Aerobics at 6:30 on Monday and Wednesday evenings. The cost for the class is \$3 or \$6 if you bring your children for childcare.

Spring and graduation pictures will be on April 14th and 15th so mark your dates! This will be a good time to have sibling pictures made since schools are closed that week for Spring Break.
